577.20 To confirm the minutes of the Parish Council meeting held on 10th September 2020: Cllr Chris Glover proposed, Cllr Emma Green seconded and all agreed that the minutes were a true record of the meeting and will be signed by the chairman in due course

578.20 Declarations of Interest: None

579.20 Public Session: Mersea Island Society had sent a letter asking for opinions about a proposed cycle path. It was thought that gaining permission from land owners would be very problematic. The question of funding for this project and maintenance costs were raised. These points will be taken back to MI Society. Further enquiries will be made with regard to lengthening the yellow lines along the far end of East Road. **580.20 Borough Clir report:** CBC Draft Local Plan Part 1 has still not been signed off therefore Part 2 has also yet to be agreed which concerns future planning rules for applications.

581.20 County Cllr report: Highways would not fund proposed new signage for Bromans Lane so this has been directed to Cudmore Grove. Speed assessment strips have been ordered to gauge the possible need for a VAS along East Road following complaints of speeding.

582.20 Countrywide Litter Pick: East Mersea litter pick has yet to be organised, the Zone Warden will be consulted for his attendance if possible.

583.20 Path to Prosperity: An on-line meeting was attended by EMPC and WMTC with the ECC Liaison Team to discuss the proposal for a digital path network. Suggested paths and walkways can be submitted which is accessible from a phone

App. Parking was a concern with regard to MI which will be investigated further.

584.20 Speeding on East Road: The parish council has agreed to pay half the cost (£200) for the installation of the assessment strips in a bid to push this forward. This installation will be requested for the beginning of next April (school Easter holidays) for maximum effect.

585.20 Honours Nominations: Names were suggested for both UK National Honours and Covid-19 related awards which will be considered further

586.20 Caravan Parks: The sites have been written to by CBC concerning persistent residency, some offenders have already been evicted and other matters are still being dealt with.
