**57.25 The minutes** of the meeting held on Thursday 8th May 2025 were agreed and accepted by all as a true record of the meeting and signed by the chairman. The June meeting was cancelled owing to too many councillors being unable to attend.

58.25 Declarations of Interest: None

**59.25 Public Participation Session:** Concern was expressed from one resident about a neighbouring property which will be send to CCC Enforcement to investigate. A number of questions were raised with regard to the RCCE survey and low-cost housing scheme which the parish council were unable to answer at this stage. Also, dissatisfaction was expressed with other aspects of the project which again, would be far too early in the proceedings to give conclusive opinions or answers on.

**60.25 City Clirs Report:** Local Government Reorganisation consultation is on the home page of Colchester City Council website until 20<sup>th</sup> July. There is still much discussion about number of councils to join up into the unitary councils and other related matters. The Draft Local Plan consultation is scheduled to be out on 10<sup>th</sup> November 2025.

**61.25 RCCE Affordable/Low-Cost Housing:** The detailed report from RCCE, following the survey, has been received and will be displayed on the website in due course. It shows sufficient interest in a small development of this type of housing for local people enabling them to stay in the village where as they would otherwise not be able to and so RCCE recommend we move this on to the next stage, the parish council supports this.

**62.25 Seawall** – the reply from the Environment Agency, re our concerns over insufficient repair work, says they will carry out this work in late summer/early autumn and we will be asking for a further update on the timescale in August.
